



## Community Group Curriculum | Psalm 15

### Opening Question:

1. Follow up from last week's discussion question on Scripture reading. Were you able to implement anything you discussed? Did you notice any themes that God was speaking to you? Going forward into this next week, what daily rhythms do you want to continue doing, or what would you change?

### Discussion Questions:

2. The Psalmist begins by posing two questions to God. No matter where we are on our faith journey, we all have questions. If you could ask God one thing, what would it be?
3. Psalm 15 describes the characteristics of someone who will dwell with God. Despite our best attempts, we are incapable of measuring up to this. This leads us to accept that we need a saviour, and a relationship with him. Read Romans 3:21-31.
  - a. Why should we strive to constantly become like someone described in Psalm 15 even though we will fall short?
  - b. Does this make you run to or from God? How can psalms like this draw you closer to God?

### “Going Deeper” Questions:

4. The answer to the question in verse 1 describes the characteristics of someone who lives in the house of God. Namely, someone who is sincere, righteous, honest, without slander, without doing wrong, distinguishes between good and evil, has integrity, does not take interest, and does not accept bribes.
  - a. Break off into groups of 2 or 3 same-gender groups. We are all works in progress. Which area of the previous list do you find the most challenging and what can you do to work on it this week?
